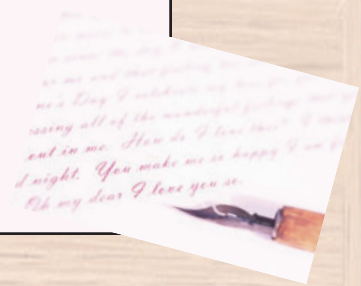


# Women of Grace News & Views
